No legitimate bike shop or other business will buy a bike that is marked, unless appropriate identification is used. Similarly, your car will be marked with a decal indicating the age range and sex of regular drivers. If a male teenager is spotted driving a car marked as having only a female driver it will be stopped. Deterrence is the only protection we have, and this the only available method of deterrence we can offer, please come by and get both your car and bike identified. Incidentally, we'll probably need some help, so stop by and chat and grab a pencil.

There has been a suggestion that some senior citizens have not been able to attend our monthly meetings because they have no transportation. Likewise, any senior who would like to take advantage of the safety and convenience of a ride to our meetings is encouraged to call.

Gripe

As I was preparing to work on this issue of Action News, I passed PS133 and noticed that a fire had apparently been set in the school's garbage, and refuse was strewn all over the sidewalk. It is possible that this was an accident, but I fear it was the work of vandals. I beg all of you, adults and children alike, to respect this lovely and quiet neighborhood we have. Its hard to understand how peaceful and nice it is around here, but take a look around when you pass through other areas. We have struggled to keep pride in the neighborhood and we need it. Please, let's not do anything to disturb this great area.

We mentioned last month that the cable company is planning to begin installation in Bellerose this year. A presentation was given to the Community Board recently, by the Brooklyn-Queens Cable TV Co. and their schedule calls for commencement of service in this neighborhood as early as June of this year. They mentioned that most of the promotion for the systems would be done by direct mail and some local advertising, but there will be some follow-up door-to-door soliciting. They assured us that all of their installers and salespeople have identifications and jackets with insignias. Be sure to check before you let anyone in. The installation will be done on telephone posts which many of us have in our back yards. The cable company has an easement granted from the phone company and they are entitled access to the poles. They are supposed to notify the owner, however, before entering your property.

The prices will range from about \$12 minimum per month, \$16 monthly "standard package", \$34 average user cost to over \$50 for a full package, so it doesn't come cheap. There is no discount for homeowners for use of utility poles on your property.

June Walk

The general membership, at the March meeting approved our annual June Walk appropriation. Once again, Mary Ann Hellenbrecht has agreed to Chair the event, but needs help to pull together all the pieces. The Board, in presenting the appropriation, explained that the event is a patriotic and civic pride issue, which is the most visible activity the Association has to pull the community together and show that we are a strong and healthy neighborhood.

If we are to be successful, Mary Ann needs several people to help out with a range of responsibilities; she cannot do it all herself.
