U.S.M.M.A.

Just beyond Great Neck, in the town of Kings Point, the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy is located on 68 acres of grounds fronting Long Island Sound. Dedicated to the training and education of officers for the American Merchant Marine and U.S. Naval Reserve, Congressionally appointed young men and women from all over the country come here as students. The area is open to the public daily from 9-5. Football games are played with suitable opponents on their regulation-size field -- a real treat to be taken advantage of by sports enthusiasts in the area each Fall, and regimental reviews are held some Saturday mornings in the Spring (May-June) and Fall (Sept.-Oct.).


The U.S. Merchant
Marine Memorial Chapel
is a very beautiful
and unique ediface to
see. Large unadorned
windows overlooking
the water surround the
convertible altar --

actually three altars - Catholic, Jewish and Protestant -- which revolves to the foreground for each respective service. A framed letter from President John F. Kennedy on the occasion of the dedication of the Chapel in 1961 may be seen hung in the Chapel.

Immediately adjacent to the grounds is the recently opened Gift Shop and Museum at the Barstow Mansion. Still in the stages of being assembled, much remains in storage awaiting placement in this beautiful home which once belonged to the partner of Thomas Edison. is a hand painted ceiling in one room, signed and dated 1930 by the artist, which in itself is worth the trip. A transparent plexiglass scale model used to build every Liberty ship is in their possession. Scale models of other ships, nautical instruments, dishes, menus are among the treasures to be seen. A huge trophy awarded the United States Lines for breaking the world record from the U.S. to Europe is currently on view at Kings Point. This growing collection promises to have a bright future.

If you happen to have an interest in things of the sea, remember Kings Point is a scant seven miles away. Further information may be had by calling 516-482-8200.
