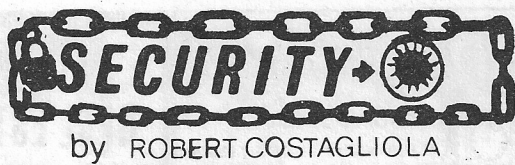
The HOT LINE

Many thanks to Ed Tuerack, President of the Queens Village-Hollis-Bellerose Volunteer Ambulance Corp. for his most informative talk before our general membership meeting. Our Community is very fortunate to have such dedicated citizens available should their services be needed.

The Corp. stressed the importance of each home owner to have their address clearly visible in the front of their house. If you should be waiting for the Corp. to arrive, it is helpful if someone is outside to direct the ambulance to the emergency. Should this happen at night, the use of a flashlight is urged as it is a great help to the driver of the ambulance to find the correct house.

Let your opinions be known to your NYC elected representatives--with the national unemployment rate of 8.2%--and even higher in NYC--with projections of a still worsening economy during 1975, our real estate taxes may be raised 10%. Presently \$7.74/\$100 of assessed value would be increased to \$8.09. We are being taxed to death! Presently we pay an auto use tax, we see an increase in tolls, taxes on gasoline, etc. What price do we have to pay for poor fiscal management?
