

Bellerose Commonwealth Civic Association. 2/23/65 at P.S. 133

Minutes of the previous meeting read and accepted.

In the absence of the Corresponding Secy., Mrs. Fallon spoke on correspondence, but none was read.

Mr. McCarthy gave a report on the last meeting of the Board of Directors.

Mrs. Fallon asked for discussion on the possibility of the Association Incorporating. She said the cost would be \$50.00 for the Incorporation and \$7.50 to affix the State seal; for a total cost of \$57.50. A motion was made by Mrs. Fehling and seconded by Mr. Fiorito that we Incorporate. The motion was carried unanimously.

There was a discussion on the possibility of having a dance in June in connection with the installation of officers, since this will be the Association's 30th Anniversary. A motion was made by Mr. Seminara and seconded by Mr. Nolan that we hold a Dinner-Dance. The motion was carried by a close margin. Then Mr. Seminara made a motion to amend the previous motion so that a committee to be formed would be empowered to decide the type of Dance to be held. This was seconded by Mr. D'Agostino and carried unanimously. Then a vote was taken to accept the motion as amended. The motion as amended was carried by a large margin.

The Dance committee members are: Mr. Joseph Seminara; Mrs. Betty Lou Cameron; Mr. Nolan; Mrs. Grace Fiorito.

Mr. Nichols made a motion that a new 50 star flag be bought for the Association to replace the old 48 star flag. It was seconded by Mr. Fehling, and was carried unanimously.

Next, Mr. Nichols, who had obtained the proposed assessed valuations for 1965-66 said that most had remained the same. There were 27 upped valuations which he read off to us. A discussion followed.

Mrs. Fallon then spoke of the proposed Sewer Assessments. She said that the proper time, a notice would be distributed giving a time and place for Protest Petitions to be signed.

Mr. McCarthy suggested that a committee be appointed to follow these Assessments in every way possible. The committee consists of: Mr. James McCarthy; Mrs. Matilda Nickel; Mr. Walter Gramlich; and Mrs. Joan Fiorentino.
