

Bellerose Commonwealth Civic Assoc. 5/26/64 at Roper's.

Minutes of previous meeting read and accepted. Correspondence read and commented on.

Mrs. Fallon immediately took up the Sewer Assessment problem. She read a circular put out by Robt. McMillan who was forming a committee to fight assessment. Mrs. Fallon stated that the bills will be out in July and August - some Oct. & Nov.

All sewer assessments were being lumped into one. Eastern Queens Council felt it wise not to go out with petitions this summer, but to await more awareness upon the part of other city areas when all bills were out and action would be spurred. Any money paid should be "Paid under Protest" so that if any was to be returned in the future, only checks so marked would be given that consideration. Mrs. Fallon also asked membership to determine how much assessments had been paid on their property through past years. No more than \$1000. should be assessed on a 40x100 property. Further general discussion of the matter took place.

Mrs. Fallon then spoke of her efforts to have trees replaced on Little Neck Parkway where they had been removed by the building of a new gas station. Two trees were to be planted in the fall.

There was a complaint about a loose sewer cover on 251 St. Miss McCarthy was to write to the proper department.

Mr. Lorio, Chairman of the Nominating Committee was not present so Mrs. Fallon read the present slate of officers and then threw open the meeting to nominations from the floor.

Discussion of our 30th Anniversary Year plans followed. Many suggestions made. Committee formed:- Mrs. Jean Brown, Chr., Members: Messrs. Nichols, Hennessey, Ortiz and Begley. It was left to the Committee to discuss and to submit report in the fall as to what might be done and the costs involved.

Our thanks were extended to Mr. Roper for supplying meeting place and coffee and cake for refreshment time after meeting.
