Minutes of previous meeting read and accepted.

Our new Flag, which was purchased earlier this season was shown.

Mr. McCarthy mentioned that our meeting was written up in the L.I. Press last Sunday, November 13th. He thanked Mr. Theophil for seeing to this coverage.

A motion was made by Joan Brown that another letter be written regarding the urgent need for a traffic light on Hillside Ave. at the West side of Cross Island Parkway. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Mr. Springer discussed the traffic problem of cars using 84th Road as a cut off after leaving Cross Island Parkway. The possibility of having that street made into a "One Way" Street going West was discussed. No letter is to be written until he reports on the feeling of the other people living on that block is determined. Mr. Springer will make a report on this at our next meeting.

Mr. Fehling spoke about a hearing on Nov. 29th at the Board of Standards and Appeals for changes in variance of zoning along Commonwealth Blvd. He said builders had bought on speculation to build on small off sized lots - for instance, one lot is 30' by 40', another is 105' by 22'. Mr. Guerin said that he thought a letter of protest signed by those present was in order. Mrs. Fallon also spoke in favor of this. Mr. McCarthy thought the limited number of signatures might be taken as a sign of weakness rather than unity, and that it might rather work against the cause. After a discussion a motion was made by Mr. Hennessy, seconded by Mr. Fehling and carried unanimously that a letter be written and signed by the Officers and Board of Directors of the Organization.

Mr. McCarthy then discussed the pending Sewer Assessments. He said that as of this moment, the situation was just the same, and that there was nothing more for us to do until the bills actually come out. This he thought would happen after the First of the Year.

Meeting adjourned at 10:00P.M.
