
BOATING


START ANEW

It must be stressed that strict anonymity is observed at all times. Information about joining may be obtained by calling 343-4782. For the family and friends of the alcoholic, a meeting of Al Anon is held every Saturday evening at 8:30 p.m. also in the basement of St. Gregory's Convent. These groups provide supportiveness through unity, sharing and the knowledge that others are going through the same difficulties.
