BUYING A NEW BOILER??

State Senator Frank Padavan has advised us that the Senate has approved rebates, funded through the state Energy Office from restitution payments resulting from overcharges by the petroleum industry. The rebates of up to \$180 will be granted on a first-come, first-served basis to homeowners who are installing REPLACEMENT OIL HEATERS in their residences only, after November 30, 1987. There are certain restrictions as to the size of the dwelling (less than 4 families) and the quality of the new heater, but if you are contemplating a new system, now is the time to do it, if you can take advantage of this rebate.

For specifics, please call the State Energy Office on this toll-free Hotline: 1-800-342-3722. Remember, this only covers new, replacement oil fired heating systems and does not include kerosene, propane, natural gas or other systems.

TRAFFIC CONTROLS

John Harley, Vice President and chairman of the Transportation committee had asked a representative of the Transportation Department to come to our December meeting, but they declined because they were just beginning a new survey of 86th Avenue and felt they wouldn't have anything to offer. CABLE TV

The BQ Cable Company made a presentation before the Community Board in December. Believe it or not they are continuing the installations, although most of us have not heard one word from them. Their time table currently calls for final completion of all "street side" installations by the end of February. The problem has been with back yard poles. Despite agreements with utilities, who have easement rights to these poles, the homeowners are either not allowing access or are not around to let them in. The schedule for completing back yard poles is August.
