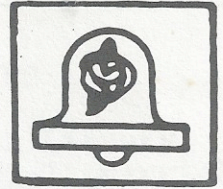

SANITATION

Homeowners and Merchants in our community take pride in the appearance of their property and, we are sure, wish to cooperate fully with the Department of Sanitation. It has come to our attention, however, that possibly some of their regulations are unknown to the public, since it has been noted that violations, punishable by summons and a refusal of pickup, have been cited.

Use a good covered garbage can for your home. Do not let garbage overflow onto the street or sidewalks.

Tie tightly bundles of newspaper, rubbish or rags.

Keep waste material inside until day of collection. Please remove containers from sidewalks as soon as possible after being emptied.

New York City law requires that all homeowners and merchants sweep their sidewalks and 18" of gutter in front of their homes or businesses each day. This material should then be picked up and disposed of properly. Violators of this law face a fine of from \$50 to \$250. The Sanitation Police are responsible for enforcement.

Keep sidewalks clear of snow and ice.

Curb your dog and dispose of droppings.

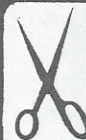
MOVIES
