Graffiti, What's Next

Once again our primary thoroughfare, Hillside Avenue, has been besieged by graffiti-ists. These vandals have again ruined what many of us worked so hard on last year. This is truly frustrating, demoralizing and depressing.

Graffiti has been a problem throughout Queens, but we thought we had licked it. After many neighbors gave up a Saturday scrubbing everything in sight, our stores remained clean for at least six months. Now, in the middle of the winter when one would least expect it, almost all of the graffiti has returned.

Graffiti is not just a social unpleasantry, it is the first step toward a general breakdown in respect for authority and the law. A graffiti-ist is saying "I don't give a damn about you, your property or your laws." His next steps are bigger crimes, like mugging,

auto theft or car jacking - it's only a small transition to getting a gun and then using it.

This Sunday's Newsday had an article on how our precinct, the 105, experienced a remarkable surge in the murder rate during 1992. Homicides went from 16 in 1991 to 47 in 1992 - one of the few precincts in the City that reported an increase. The paper pinned this increase on increased drug use and availability of guns.

As corny as this sounds, I firmly believe there is a strong correlation to committing a crime, getting away with it then doing more serious crime.

Graffiti has a serious effect on adults. Frequently adults feel "well if no one else cares about how the neighborhood looks, why not let my sidewalk crack or drop my old refrigerator on the old railroad spur at Commonwealth. Hey, why not sell now while the getting's good."

Parents and neighbors, we cannot let graffiti get the better of our town and our youth. We must treat graffiti as the serious crime that it is. We must fight and fight hard.

One immediate step is to watch for signs of vandalism on

children, like coming in very late, signs of paint on hands or clothing, spray cans around the house, and graffiti "tags" on school books. All residents should immediately report graffiti crimes in progress. Call 911 if you see vandalism in progress. The Borough President has targeted graffiti as a top priority urging us all to take back our communities. BP Shulman urges us to call (212)374-5914 or 5719 to report the description of vandals and location of graffiti. In calling this number you do not have to give your name!

Please treat this crime as more than just the nuisance that it is. If we all want to be proud of our neighborhood as we were, we must take control and stop this mess.

sonal documents of all sorts are delivered by mail. We must be ensured that every conceivable precaution is made to get the mail to its destination.

The letter also reported that after years of regular before noon deliveries, mail is now delivered late in the day, often after dark when many of our senior citizens are reluctant to open their doors.
