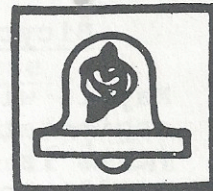



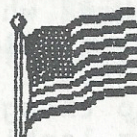
## Meetings

## Bicycle/Car Registration

May 16 will be our annual bicycle registration at "Bellerose Park" (this is the official name for PS133's park) from 10AM to 2PM. This process affixes a permanent number into the bike's frame which identifies it as registered through the 105 Pct. Any dealer touching the bike will be asking some questions, therefore, we consider it to be a deterrent to thefts. It does not, however, take the place of locks and we strongly suggest you lock your bike at all times.

The car registration will also take place at the Park on May 16. The registration is in the form of a decal placed on a window which identifies the sex and age of the likely drivers in your family and your precinct. If there is anything suspicious about the driver the police can quickly check the sticker. Again, it's a deterrent to theft. We need volunteers to help with these processes, if you are available, please stop by anytime during the above hours to help out.

## June Walk Canceled

It is with deep regret that we must cancel the annual June Walk this year due to a lack of assistance in coordination. After two months of seeking volunteers, we had only four people who offered to spend some time and energy to pull this event off. Since there are usually about six committees who pay attention to various details over three months, this wasn't enough. We won't give up though. We will be back next year looking for help and ideas for what we think is the most important activity of the association. We hope you'll have more time then to help our community enjoy a festive afternoon.

## Legislative Reports

Senator Padavan reports that the legislature has approved an 11% increase in State aid for City schools for '87-'88, which represents a larger pro-rata share than other areas. In this aid, district 26 will benefit by special program funds of nearly \$500,000 for such programs as the Drug-Alcohol Awareness Program, computer training, gifted and talented programs. From other funding enactments, other area benefits were Queens Colony Farm Museum funding, St. Gregory's Community Counseling Center, SNAP and APEC.

Councilman Leffler reports working hard as part of his responsibility as chair of the Council's Environmental Protection Committee to increase environmental resources in the budget process to provide additional inspection of our upstate water supply, improve leak detection, install retrofit water limiters in city owned buildings. He also has as a priority, sanitation issues, such as more supervisors, increased productivity and weeding of concrete traffic malls. I'm sure our friends along 253rd Street will love that.

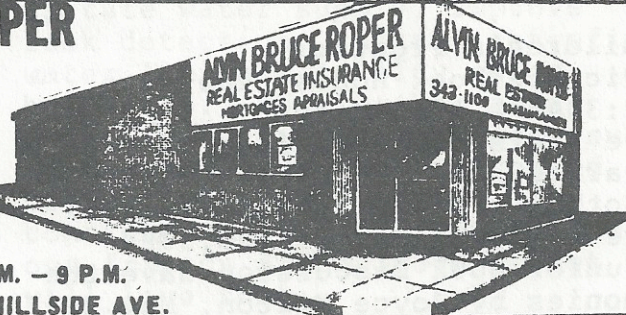
