Rainbarrel Project—NYC DEP has initiated a pilot project in our area to demonstrate the use of rainbarrels on one-family homes to save water and reduce runoff. DEP is looking for 250 volunteers by June 1 to use the rainbarrels for a two year pilot, after which the equipment will be the property of the homeowner. All equipment and materials will be provided by DEP, but the homeowner will be responsible for installation and maintenance and to allow occasional access for monitoring.

occasional access for monitoring.
The program uses special sealed 55 gallon drums attached to your downspout to collect rainwater for use in watering plants.
The water is non-potable. A spigot near the bottom is used to fill watering cans or drip hoses. There is no cost to the home-owner. Let us know if you are interested. See Ad on back—A local resident has started a new business and asked to do a special ad. If you or your child needs com-
